The college resumed with caution and care with utmost SOP of COVID 19 2021-2022 as the Principle, Convenor and the members of the committee against sexual harassment at work place met in the office of the Principal to discuss the issues regarding the girl students and their welfare as they face physical exploitation, problems and harassment at workplace. It was decided to address the fresh students of first year of all the streams will be addressed in the college auditorium tocreate awareness and to educate the students against the dangers of sexual harassment, child abuse, physical exploitation and domestic violence. In this connection the Principal, the convenor and the members of the committee conducted a program for the students of the fresh first year of all streams on 17th September 2021 whereby around 580 students joined the program. The Principal and Convenor delivered enthralling discourses on sexual harassment, child abuse and domestic violence. Students were told about the laws which protect women especially the girl children from sexual harassment at workplace, the students were really curious and raised manythought-provoking queries, which were appropriately answered by the committee members.

On April 17, 2022 the Principal, the Convener and members of the committee against sexual harassment at work, met in a meeting to review whether there was any complaint or information about exploitation or victimization or sexual harassment of students of the college. No complaint was received



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during this year. The Principal, the Convener and members of the committee discussed the topic comprehensively and it was finally decided that there is no reason to be complacent as the girls of the college are vulnerable against any kind of harassment and every girl student must me sensitized against the sexual harassment at workplace.
