1) Shrimati Nidhi Lakhanpal Jyoti Memorial Scholarships:



- a) This scholarship, introduced in memory of Smt Nidhi Jyoti, an ex-student of RKMV, aims to support deserving students through 11 merit-cum-means scholarships.
- b) Scholarships are available for students from the Economics and Music departments, as well as the top students in Arts, Science, and Commerce streams.
- c) Additionally, scholarships are provided to physically challenged students or those from economically weaker sections (EWS).
- **Impact**: This scholarship not only supports academic growth but also reflects Smt Nidhi Jyoti's values of women's empowerment and excellence in education.

2. RKMV Merit-Based Scholarships:

- a) These scholarships recognize students' academic achievements in their first and second years of study. The scholarships encourage academic dedication and performance.
- **Impact**: Merit-based scholarships have proven effective in motivating students to maintain high academic standards and remain focused on their studies.

3. RKMV Need-Based Scholarships:

- a) Launched in the 2024-25 session, this scholarship targets students who face financial difficulty in purchasing necessary syllabus books.
- b) By alleviating the financial strain associated with educational resources, the program ensures that students can access their required materials without hindrance.
- **Impact**: This scholarship addresses an immediate financial need, ensuring that talented students from financially weaker backgrounds are not deprived of their academic materials.

4. Learn and Earn Internship Program:

- a) Starting from the 2024-25 session, this internship program is designed to provide financial assistance to students who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership potential, and commitment to community service.
- b) The internships, offered in various subjects and through clubs and societies, will allow students to work part-time while pursuing their studies.
- **Impact**: This initiative is a key step towards ensuring that students can cover fees, living expenses, and other costs, while also gaining valuable professional experience.

o Faculty Guidance







Professors and faculty members actively inform students about scholarship opportunities, especially those eligible for specific programs such as merit-based or need-based scholarships.

1. Simplified Application Procedures:


- o RKMV actively works to simplify application processes for its students, ensuring they have access to all the information and tools they need to complete applications accurately and on time.
