TRAINING OUTCOMES:


- i. Students knowledge about British Shimla was enhanced






4) MOU between Milk Bag Project and RKMV

On 21st February, 2024 a demonstration cum talk was organized in the staff room with Principal Dr. Anurita Saxena and other staff members. The workshop was conducted to start and demonstrate a project on milk packet collection and recycling to reduce the menace under best practice of RKMV. A demonstration on how to cut and clean the milk packets was done so as to avoid not dropping small parts of plastic milk packets which can further contribute to micro-plastic pollution if left in the environment. This was followed by a healthy discussion by the staff members and the team where they cleared out doubts and queries. Staff members were asked to encourage their students too to come forward for this noble cause. February 2024, 8 days collection was 1.624Kg through milk packets. These packets were sent to 3 member's team NGO based out of Mumbai. The packets were sent via Indian Post. The March 2024 total collection was 3.910Kg and the collection in April 2024 was 8.693 Kg, May's total collection was 11.745 Kg and June was 12.456 Kg.








5) MOU between Biodiversity board and RKMV

6) Pennsylvania, USA and RKMV

On 8th April 2024, The IQAC of RKMV in partnership with Penn State University, Pennsylvania, USA hosted a Workshop on 'Global Horizons: Foreign Collaborations Under National Education Policy (NEP), 2020'. The Chief Guest of this event was Shri Rakesh Kanwar, Secretary (Education), Government of Himachal Pradesh. In his Keynote address, he endorsed and elaborated on 'Multilingualism and Cultural Diversity' as foregrounded by NEP, 2020. He also brought forth the need to break the 'Hierarchy of Intelligence' in which some subjects are favoured over the others and also advised the educators to focus on the mental health of the students. The other dignitaries present in the Workshop were Dr Tina Q. 
