# 16th October 2024

RKMV celebrated its 46th Annual Prize Distribution Function for the 2023-24 academic year with great enthusiasm. The event was made even more significant by the inauguration of the new Block 'C' building. The function was graced by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Sh. Sukhvinder Singh as the Chief Guest, along with other distinguished guests including Sh. Harish Janartha, MLA of Shimla Urban, Sh. Surender Chauhan, Mayor of Shimla, Sh. Anupam Kashyap,Deputy Commissioner and Dr. Amarjeet Sharma, Director of Higher Education.



The Principal presented the College's Annual Report, highlighting its achievements, performances, and future vision. Awards were given to meritorious students across various fields such as academics, sports, youth festivals, clubs and societies, NCC, and volunteer services.


#### 25th November 2024
