- **Creation of a New Conference Hall:** A new conference hall has been successfully established. It is fully equipped with a large screen and modern amenities to facilitate meetings, seminars, and student gatherings. To facilitate meetings, seminars, and student gatherings, a new conference hall is under construction. It will be equipped with a large screen and modern amenities to enhance presentations and discussions. The project is currently in progress.
- **Purchase of New Computers for Computer Lab:** The outdated systems in the computer lab have been replaced with new computers. This upgrade aims to improve the learning experience for students, ensuring they have access to the latest technology and software.
- **Deployment of Guest Lecturers:** Several academic departments had vacancies, affecting the quality of education. To address this, guest lecturers have been hired and deployed in the respective departments, ensuring uninterrupted learning for students.

New Demands by Students:

- **Required Dust Bins for Block-C:** Students have requested the installation of additional dust bins in Block C to maintain cleanliness and promote proper waste disposal. This initiative aims to enhance hygiene standards and encourage responsible waste management among students and staff.
 - **Display Board for Meritorious Students:** To recognize and encourage academic excellence, students have proposed the installation of a display board showcasing the achievements of meritorious students. This initiative will serve as motivation for students to perform better and create a culture of healthy academic competition.
 - **Continuation of Services of Guest Lecturers and Resources:** Students have expressed the need to continue the services of guest lecturers and additional academic resources. These lecturers provide valuable insights, industry exposure, and specialized knowledge that enrich the learning experience. Maintaining their presence will ensure consistency in education and bridge gaps in faculty vacancies.
- Dr. Surinder Sharma thanked everyone for their participation and concluded the meeting.

Action Taken:

Strengthening of Career Guidance & Placement Cell.

Conduct of career counselling, resume writing, and interview preparation sessions.

Collaboration with industries for internships and placement drives.

6. Infrastructure & Learning Resources

Observations:

Facilities are adequate but require further improvement in ICT.

Action Taken:

Upgradation of ICT-enabled classrooms and digital resources.

Enhancement of library and laboratory facilities.

Improved Wi-Fi and e-learning access.

Future Plan (Next Academic Session)

Focus on outcome-based education (OBE).

Increased industry-academia interaction.

Promote research, innovation, and entrepreneurship.

Enhance student participation in national/international platforms.

Continuous monitoring by IQAC for quality improvement.
