

# **CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT (CCA)**

- The 30 marks under CCA will be determined by the concerned teacher on the basis of the following components:
  1. Mid-Term Test = 10 marks (B.A./ B.Com./ B.Sc.) (15 marks in case of Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science)
  2. Class Test = 5 marks (B.A./ B.Com./ B.Sc. Physics, Zoology, Botany)
  3. Assignments/ Seminars = 10 marks
  4. Classroom Attendance = 5 marks
- Classroom attendance will be defined as follows:
  - >75% but <80% = 1 mark.
  - >80% but <85% = 2 marks
  - >85% but <90% = 3 marks
  - >90% but <95% = 4 marks
  - >95% to 100% = 5 marks

## **MID-TERM AND CLASS TESTS**

- Mid-Term Test, which is mandatory for every student to take, will be conducted in each course during the academic year. Mid-Term test will be conducted on completion of 75% of the syllabus.

- Class test will be conducted on completion of 40% of the syllabus.  
**Note:** As per the University guidelines, the student who does not score 35% marks in CCA and fails to have minimum 75% class room attendance will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination.
